Eligibility Requirements:

- **Enrollment** - Student must be enrolled and participating in interscholastic athletics. District Athletic Director or sport Head Coach must be a member of the [Texas High School Athletic Director Association](#).
- **Senior Status** - Student must be a senior graduating during the current school year.
- **Varsity Letter** – Prior to their senior year, Student must have earned a varsity letter in a sport where there is post-season competition.
- **Minimum GPA** - Student must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. (Grade point cannot be rounded “up” for the purpose of qualifying.)

Application Sections, Scoring & Helpful Hints:

- Applicant Information (Pg.1) – Complete all sections, especially Class Rank, GPA and Test Scores.
- Extra-Curricular Activities Form (Pg.2) – Focus on significant participation and leadership experiences, athletic achievements, academic awards and community involvement.
- Short Answer Questions (Pg.3) – Use this space to tell us more about how you’ve personally benefitted from your activity in both school sponsored and non-school activities.
- Essay (Pg.4) – Write an essay on the importance of Sportsmanship in Educational Athletics. (500-word maximum). *Be Creative!* Use personal experiences, if appropriate.

- Print a copy of the PDF document then fill it out. Be sure to complete all sections. Send to the THSADA Office (see below).
- Please send the application in the order shown above (Pg.1-Pg.4) Incomplete applications will not be judged.

- Schools are limited in the number of applications they may submit. Please check with your athletic director before filing out and sending this application.
