I am asking for head coaches to get their requests in soon. We will use the same format as we did last year. List everything on <u>PURCHASE REQUISITION FORMS</u> as detailed as you can with a price as close as you can come to the real thing. It does not have to be accurate. Call your vendors for assistance.

We have received our athletic allocation for next school year. Once again, it will remain the same, with the possible addition of new sports on your campus. Please be realistic when sending in your requests. Please stop with the requests for thousands of dollars when you know very well what you can be expecting or at least pretty close.

This office is still accepting wish list requests. If there is a minor issue that we might be able to assist you with, send in the req and the quote. No guarantees, but it is worth a try. We have been able to help out many of our programs with any monies that we have in this year's budget (old money).

Your requests must be in by <u>Friday 31 May</u> at the end of the day. It should include supplies (6399) and employee travel/clinics (6411). Be as detailed as you can. For any information about your accounts, contact Karen or Andrea so that they can give you a better figure for what you spent on your program.

Please be reminded that for your employee travel (6411) account, include any possible scouting, to include meals, rental, lodging. We don't want to take away from your clinic monies, but, normally, have to because of the other expenses that you incur during the school year. This account also includes your meals for any additional travel. Clinics held in town will be paid for by this office (no memberships, just clinic fees).

When traveling during school time, sack meals will continue to be provided by district in place of breakfast and/or lunch. For golf, tennis, track coaches, we see that most of you are now substituting snacks and drinks (water, Gatorade, energy bars, fruit, etc) for actual meals. We believe this is the healthy way to go. We ask that you continue this practice and get away from burgers, fries, pizza, chips, cokes, etc.

Do list your clinics (6411) in your budget requests. If you do not put anything down, I will assume that you are not looking to go to a clinic next school year and will not allocate anything. Remember, you cannot miss school time to attend an athletic clinic.

If you have any questions, contact this office. Remember, Friday 31 May 2019 is the due date for your budgets.
